The Part Time Complete Make-Up Diploma is perfect for aspiring make-up artists who are ready to begin their career but who also want to work part time throughout the course. The part time syllabus covers the same topics as the full time course and prepares students to gain a direct route into the industry.

Week 1 & 2

Straight & Corrective Make-Up

Week 5 & 6

Camouflage & Period Make-Up

- Camouflaging tattoos / skin discolouration
- Colour correction techniques
- 'No make-up' make-up

Week 7 & 8

Contemporary & Fashion Hair Styling

- Health and Safety
- Equipment used for latest hair trends

Week 9 & 10

Period Hair Dressing

- Blocking and cleaning wigs
- Use of equipment to create period shapes
- Researching period styles
- Dressing both wigs and own hair
- *Period hairdressing*: follows on from period make-up module
- Victorian & 20th century decades

Week 11 & 12

Cut & Blow Dry Hair

- Health and safety
- Use of tools/products
- Sectioning and cutting female hair
- Blow dry
- Basic barbering male hair
- Trimming long hair

Week 13 & 14

HD Airbrushing: TV, Fashion & Bridal (2 Days)

- Using both airbrush specific make-up & standard make-up through the airbrush
- Cleaning and troubleshooting
- Airbrushing skin, eyebrows, eyes, contours, cheeks and highlights.

Body Painting (3 Days)

- Sponge and brush work
- Use of airbrush, cutting stencils
- Creating illusion
- Shading and blending
- Producing final design to commercial standard

Week 15 & 16

Casualty Effects

- Applying bruises, grazes, cuts, scratches
- Scars, stitches wounds, open wounds and blood effects
- Burns of all types (1st to 3rd degree, scalding and electrical)
- Continuity over times

Week 17 & 18

Character Make-Up

- *Gender Change:* Female/Male laying on beard/hair stubble
- Race change using camouflage techniques
- *Ageing:* painted and applied
- Students work to character script
- *Student Project Day:* accurate "look-alike" & student's own research.
- Applying, cleaning & dressing facial hair

Week 19 & 20

Prosthetics & Bald Caps

- Understand & execute life casting technique
- Mould making
- Custom made bald cap demo
- Sculpting
- Understanding the different processes & materials involved in prosthetic making

Week 21 & 22

Prosthetics & Bald Caps

- Application of bald cap, blending edges to match skin tone.
- Working with scripts
- Script breakdown
- Continuity
- *Tattoo Application:* both hand-drawn and transferred
- Removing prosthetics appliances
- Application & colouring of prosthetics

Week 23 & 24

Portfolio Building & Professional Development

- *Speed Work to Brief:* scripts supplied
- *Portfolio-Building:* shoot in studio with professional models & photographer (3 days)
- *Steps to Develop Work Contacts:* C.V. advice, website advice and career development

Course Includes:

- Complete make-up and hair training that will allow you to work in the fashion, TV and film industries
- A working kit and kit bag (includes brush set and make-up kit)
- Working professional teachers and mentoring opportunities
- Work experience during and after study thanks to the LSMM in-house agency
- Life coaching & professional development (including business skills & social media e-book)
- A professional portfolio shot by a fashion photographer and agency models
